Flat Rates

Water users not connected to a meter shall be charged in accordance with the sizing of the water metering device for a similar user as outlined in the chart above. Consumption shall be estimated by taking the prior year's average monthly consumption of all consumers with similar sized meters. This estimate shall be prorated for the number of days each month.

Billing & Payment

Meter reading, billing, and collection of the City's water and sewer rates is managed by Bluewater Power. For billing inquiries call 519-337-8201.

Consumption Charge

The rates are shifting to a higher consumption charge ratio to encourage users to reduce their water consumption. Using less water helps the environment, and keeps system costs low, by reducing the need to expand the treatment plants and pipe network.
