



MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 2010 COMPLIANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE



The City of Sarnia is looking for three individuals that would be interested in being appointed to the "Compliance Audit Committee" for a four year term.

The purpose of the Compliance Audit Committee is to:

- Review any application for a compliance audit on an election candidate's election campaign finances
- Consider compliance audit applications made by electors and decide whether they should be granted or rejected
- Appoint an auditor if the application is granted
- Receive the auditor's report
- Consider the auditor's report and decide if legal proceedings should be commenced
- Advise Council if the auditor's report indicates that there were no apparent contraventions and if there appears to be reasonable grounds for the application

The City is looking for individuals with applicable experience in accounting, law, law enforcement and related academic fields in the following:

- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of municipal election campaign financial rules
- Proven analytical and decision-making skills
- Experience working on committees, task forces, or similar settings
- Availability and willingness to attend meetings
- Excellent oral and written communication skills

The Committee would meet on a as need basis only.
