Centennial Park Remediation Action Plan, Phase 2 and 3 - Andre Morin, City Engineer and Beth Gignac, Director of Parks and Recreation

Beth Gignac, Director of Parks and Recreation and Andre Morin, City Engineer, presented an overview of the Centennial Park Remediation Action Plan, Phases 2 and 3. Three public consultation opportunities have been planned prior to moving forward with conceptual plans. They responded to questions from Council.

City Engineer and Director of Parks and Recreation, dated May 4, 2015, regarding Centennial Park Remediation Action Plan, Phase 2 and 3

Moved by Councillor Mitro, seconded by Councillor Kelch, and **carried:**

That Sarnia City Council approves the overall concept plan for Phase 2 and Phase 3 of Centennial Park Remediation/Revitalization with an associated budget of up to \$5.5 million dollars.

That Sarnia City Council authorizes the allocation of \$30,000 from the Land Purchase Reserve to the Centennial Park Remediation Capital Budget, in order to properly fund the Environmental Assessment (EA) for shoreline protection works.

That Sarnia City Council approves the armour stone wall option for shoreline remediation/protection.

That Sarnia City Council authorizes staff to proceed with the demolition of the DOW People Place in 2015 for site preparation work.

That staff report back to Council on the outcome of the public consultation on final design and amenities as well as fundraising.
