

February 3, 2014 – Regular Meeting of Sarnia City Council – Minutes Excerpt

Correspondence #3

City Engineer, dated January 27, 2014, regarding Centennial Park – Funding for Environmental Studies

Moved by Councillor Burrell, seconded by Councillor Bruziewicz, and **carried:**

That Sarnia City Council allocates \$350,000 from the Capital Reserve Fund, to fund all the Environmental Studies for Centennial Park (Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments and Risk Assessments for the Legacy Sites and the entire Park site); and

That Sarnia City Council allocates \$70,000 from the Environmental Reserve, to fund current and ongoing February 3, 2014 6 maintenance activities such as fencing, associated with the park closure and continuing into the Remedial Action Plan Process.

Councillor Boushy inquired about air monitoring in Centennial Park. The City Engineer advised that air monitoring is planned when favourable weather conditions exist, and that he would report back to Council when test results are received.
