Successful applicants are given an opportunity to work on a volunteer basis without pay for a minimum period of time in the program of their choice. In addition, opportunities may be available to participate in regular or special leadership training courses. At the end of the training period an L.I.T. may apply for a further training period.

Those interested in Aquatic Programs must hold a Bronze Medallion or equivalent. L.I.T.'s are utilized in day camps, park programs, and aquatics.
