CANADA DAY PARADE Guidelines THEME: The Maple Leaf Forever - Wednesday, July 1, 2020 Please return completed application by June 17, 2020

- All entrants must provide an entry form. A \$56.50 entry fee is required for commercial entries.
 A donation to the Canada Day Parade would be appreciated for all other entries.
- 2. To accommodate marshalling, multiple units are to fill in number of vehicles on the application.
- 3. **Registrations will not be accepted after June 17, 2020.** Please indicate your intentions early. **Any refusals will be notified immediately**.
- 4. Entrants must stay in their assigned positions at all times and will be judged along the route.
- 5. Entrants will be advised on their entry number in the parade within the week before the Canada Day Festivities.
- 6. Entrants are encouraged to display **Canadian flags**.
- 7. All entrants are encouraged to provide music of a Canadian patriotic nature.
- 8. All entries are encouraged to adopt the parade theme, **The Maple Leaf Forever**. Commercial entries must be 75% **decorated in red and white**. Vehicles must cover large ads. <u>No commercial advertising</u>.
- 9. Entry of commercial vehicles strictly for the purpose of advertising is prohibited.
- 10. The spraying of water in any fashion along the parade route is strictly prohibited.
- 11. Hand-outs along the parade route must be cleared through the Parade Marshall. **Handing out any items is prohibited**. THESE BECOME LITTER IN OUR PARKS.
- All parade units will move in a forward direction at all times to maintain the flow of the parade. Marshaling begins at 9:00am with all participants prepared to move forward by 11:00am.
 Parade will officially begin to move at 11:30 a.m. SHARP! From Colborne Road in <u>close</u> order, <u>all</u> entries must advise drivers of parade protocol to avoid gaps.
- 13. All float vehicles MUST enter the marshalling area at Indian Road and Lakeshore Road intersection ONLY.
- 14. The Canada Day Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and will prohibit propaganda and/or political statements of any nature. This is a celebration of Canada's birthday only 1867 2020; 153 years!
- 15. Winners will be announced in Canatara Park following the parade, after the official Opening Ceremony on the main Bandshell (approximately 1:30 p.m.)
- 16. All disbanding must take place outside the park, out towards Sandy Lane to Victoria Street in Point Edward. No stopping within the park.
