SUBJECT: COVID-19 Update – June 3

The Sarnia Primary Control Group (SPCG) met via teleconference on June 3, 2020, at 9:15 a.m. regarding developments related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, Ontario is extending the [Declaration of Emergency](#) until June 30, 2020.

The decision supports the government's efforts to respond to the COVID-19 outbreak and protect the health and safety of Ontarians as the province reopens in a measured and responsible way.
