SUBJECT: COVID-19 Update

The Sarnia Primary Control Group (SPCG) met today regarding developments related to COVID-19.

Today Ontario released its new <u>COVID19 Response Framework</u>.

<u>The Keeping Ontario Safe & Open Framework</u> categorizes public health regions into 5 levels: prevent, protect, restrict, control & lockdown. These levels will outline the types of public health and workplace safety measures for businesses and organizations at each level, including targeted measures for specific sectors, institutions and other settings.

As of November 7, 2020, the Province will transition Public Health Unit regions to the new framework.

As the Province continues to expand access to real-time data, enhancements are also being made to <a href="www.ontario.ca/coronavirus">www.ontario.ca/coronavirus</a>, Ontario's one-stop shop for information on COVID-19.

Lambton Public Health (LPH) has confirmed that one additional COVID-19 case has been reported, bringing the active case load to four. This includes one outbreak located at Fiddick's Retirement Home in Petrolia, Ontario.

LPH is asking residents to get the influenza (flu) vaccine. Flu vaccines are available free of charge at select local pharmacies throughout Sarnia-Lambton. Demand for flu vaccine appointments continues to be high, and appointments are fully booked at some Public Health sites.
