Starting today, City Hall is implementing higher precautions to protect City Staff and the public. Over the next several days, City Hall will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized, a health and safety measure further enhancing our efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

City Hall remains open, and all services are still available to the public; however, several City employees will temporarily work from home until further notice.
