SUBJECT: COVID-19 Update

The Sarnia Primary Control Group (SPCG) met today with M.P.P. Bob Bailey, Lambton Public Health, Lambton County, Bluewater Health, Point Edward and Aamjiwnaang regarding developments related to COVID-19.

Bluewater Health has reinstated visitor restrictions as COVID-19 cases rise in community.

The province of Ontario has released an ethical framework for COVID-19 vaccine distribution, expanded COVID-19 vaccine locations, began rollout of COVID-19 vaccine, identified key groups for distribution of initial COVID-19 vaccines, appointed members of the Ministers' COVID-19 vaccine distribution task force and has collaborated with industry experts to plan the COVID-19 vaccine rollout.
