

Festivals and Events Ontario Concludes Virtual Summit and Announces 2021 Award Winners.

In December 2020, the Board of Directors of Festivals and Events Ontario (FEO) made the decision to Adapt, Pivot and Evolve from the scheduled in-person annual FEO Conference on February 22-24, 2021 in the beautiful city of Niagara Falls, to a Virtual on-line Summit. There were obvious concerns that we would not be able to accurately present the typical FEO Conference experience in an on-line environment, the reality was, there was <u>nothing</u> typical about COVID-19 and the way it had decimated the festival and event industry in Ontario. The Board and Staff of FEO felt it was incredibly important to present something to our membership base that would lift their spirits, help them connect and network with their peers, and provide education and information about what the new normal for our industry will be as we recover from the pandemic.

We proclaimed February as FEO Month and every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday we presented a fun and educational virtual experience for our members featuring live entertainment, mental health sessions and round table discussions covering a plethora of topics ranging from Government Grants to Risk Management, Emergency Preparedness to Insurance Post Pandemic and everything in between.
