SUBJECT: NEW Proof of Vaccination Requirements
Persons 12 – 18 years old and Coaches and Officials

As per the instruction issued by the Medical Officer of Health for Lambton Public Health on [October 26, 2021](#):

Effective **October 31, 2021**, facilities used for sports and/or recreational activities in the County of Lambton - which include City of Sarnia Arenas and Strangway Centre - requires that each person aged 12 years and older, at the point of entry, who attends the indoor area of the facility for the purposes of:

- actively participating
- coaching,
- officiating,
- volunteering, or
- spectating at organized sports;

are now required to provide identification and proof of being **fully or partially** vaccinated against COVID-19, or a valid medical exemption as of October 31, 2021, and identification and proof of being **fully** vaccinated against COVID-19, or a valid medical exemption as of November 30, 2021.

Examples of identification that may be used include a birth certificate, driver's license, government (Ontario or other) issued identification card, passport, citizenship card, permanent resident card, Indian Status Card or Indigenous Membership Card.

Further information will be available soon regarding the recent provincial announcement around capacity limits being lifted in these facilities.
