Acceptable Fibre

- Advertising/Junk Mail
- Bills, Statements
- Books (soft covered **ONLY**)
- Boxboard (cereal boxes, egg cartons - **NO Styrofoam**)
- Brown Kraft Paper
- Catalogues
- Flyers
- Household paper
- Magazines
- Molded pulp (coffee trays, paper molds for packaging)
- Newspapers/Newsprint
- Paper (office, writing, etc.)
- Paper cores (toilet, paper towel rolls)
- Phone books
- Pizza boxes (**no food or grease**)
- Corrugated cardboard (flattened, bundled, and no larger than 1m x 1m x 0.5m)
- Shredded paper is the **ONLY** acceptable material to be placed in transparent bags.

Acceptable Glass, Cans, Plastic

Only rinsed plastics coded #1, #2, #4, #5, & #6. Caps should be left on all bottles.

- #1 plastic (PET) caps attached
 - Soft drink bottles, water bottles, juice bottles, liquor bottles, cooking oil bottles, peanut butter containers, dish soap bottles, mouth wash bottles, clear egg cartons, bakery, clamshells, trays, oven/microwavable trays
- #2 plastics (HDPE) caps attached
 - Plastic juice, milk, laundry soap, shampoo, and windshield washer containers (Acceptable if there is no skull symbol; if there is skull symbol it is not recyclable and goes to Household Hazardous Waste (HHW))
- #4, #5, & #6 plastics
 - Yogurt containers, margarine tubs, and lids
 - #2 & #5 Clean flower pots, planter trays (**NO Flower Pot Hangers**)
 - Aluminum cans, rinsed
 - Aluminum foil wrap
 - Aluminum plates and trays
 - Clam shell containers
 - Fast food cups/coffee cups (**NO Styrofoam**)
 - Glass bottles (clear and coloured)
 - Metal food and beverage cans, rinsed
 - Metal paint cans - empty, dry, lid removed
 - Milk and juice cartons, rinsed
 - Plates, pots, pans

NO!

Unacceptable Blue Box Items

Recyclables in any kind of plastic bag will not be collected (e.g. grocery bag, clear bag, etc.)

- Aerosol cans
- Artwork
- Auto parts, tires, rubber
- Biohazards, medical waste
- Blister packaging
- Broken glass
- Building materials/construction materials
- Carbon, photographic, blueprint paper
- Cards (with foil, plastic, ribbon, or lamination)
- Ceramics
- Chip, snack, candy bags
- Coffee pods
- Compost material (yard waste)
- Diapers
- Drinking straws
- Electronics - computers, audio, appliances, batteries
- Facial tissue
- Fast food cartons
- Floor sweepings/dirt
- Flower pots, trays, planters (**not coded 2 or 5**)
- Furniture
- Gift wrap, gift bags, tissue paper, wrapping paper
- Glass dishes
- Hangers, laundry baskets
- Hard covered books
- Hazardous waste
- Laminated paper packaging
- Light bulbs
- Medical equipment and syringes
- Mirrors
- Motor oil bottles
- Organics (food waste)
- Paint cans with liquid paint
- Paper towels, toilet paper
- Paper with foreign material attached
- Pet waste
- Pizza boxes with food or grease
- Plastic bags (any kind)
- Sharp objects (needles, razors, etc.)
- Styrofoam
- Waxy cardboard
