RECYCLING

Rinse and place recycling in a blue box or blue container not exceeding a maximum weight of 22 kg (48lbs); separation of recyclables is not necessary. No collection limit.

RECYCLING INCLUDES:

- Newspapers, flyers and magazines
- Cardboard, bundled with jute or twine $(Up to 1m \times 1m \times 1/2m thick)$
- Plastics coded #1, #2, #4, #5 and #6
- Rinsed flower pots (no hangers) and trays
- Empty, dry metal paint cans, with lids removed
- Glass bottles
- Fast food coffee cups and lids
- Tetra pak boxes
- Milk and juice cartons
- Aluminum cans, plates, and trays
- Clean, empty pizza boxes (no food or grease)

REMINDER: tissues. napkins, paper towels, plastic cutlery, gift wrap, styrofoam, and home meal delivery boxes (lined or wax coated cardboard) are **NOT** recyclable. For more information, visit sarnia.ca or check the Recycle Coach app.

YARD WASTE & BRUSH

Yard waste includes leaves, grass, weeds, and hay or straw collected in paper bags or open containers*. No collection limit.



Brush must be separate from yard waste. Brush includes tree branches up to four inches in diameter; twigs; hedges; shrubs; vines; bushes; and corn stalks collected in open containers* or bundled with a compostable material (jute or twine) up to four feet in length. Collection limit of 10.

*Open containers must be rigid plastic without a lid, have drainage holes, and marked on two sides with an 'X'.

Yard waste or brush exceeding 22 kg (48lbs), and containers holding water **are not collected**. Yard waste mixed with brush; brush in paper bags; ferns; pine cones; tree trunks; stumps; stump grindings; mulch; root balls; clay; and pet feces are not collected.

COMPOST SITE

Hours of operation: April 3 to December 16, Monday - Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Closed Holidays

Yard waste and brush can be dropped off at the compost yard during business hours only. No charge for yard waste drop off. Brush drop off fee for commercial users only. Mulch, woodchips, and compost are available for purchase. Loader available, Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

CREDIT/DEBIT CARD PAYMENT ONLY

Yard waste mixed with brush; ferns; pine cones; brush in paper bags; tree trunks; stumps; stump grindings; mulch; root balls; clay; and pet feces are not accepted at the compost site.

Garbage collection occurs weekly.

Recycle collection occurs bi-weekly; check your designated zone.

Yard waste and brush collection occur during designated weeks throughout the year.

ALL COLLECTIONS occur on your regular collection day and must be set out by 7 a.m.

Recycle, yard waste, and brush in plastic bags or exceeding 22kg (48lbs) are not collected. Residential recycling and waste containers must not exceed 121 litres in size.

Acceptable material must be set out by the curb before 7 a.m. on your collection day, and no earlier than 6 p.m. the evening before.

LIMITS

Residential waste: limit of three bags or three containers not exceeding a maximum weight of 22kg (48lbs) and/or 121 litres in size. All garbage must be securely bagged. Additional bags must have a bag tag. Visit the City of Sarnia website for purchase locations.

LARGE ITEMS

For more acceptable large items, visit sarnia.ca or check the Recycle Coach app.

ELECTRONIC WASTE

TVs, microwaves, and small kitchen appliances are not collected. For more information, visit sarnia.ca/eWaste.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

GARBAGE

Large items will be picked up during the **first full week** of each month on your collection day.

LARGE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Furniture
- Air conditioners purged & tagged by a refrigeration company • Stoves
- Refrigerators & freezers must be purged of freon, have
- doors removed, and tagged by a refrigeration company
- Barbecues no propane tanks
- Mattresses
- Carpet must be rolled and tied, up to 4 feet in length

UNACCEPTABLE LARGE ITEMS

Cardboard boxes used as garbage containers, commercial/ industrial-sized items, auto parts, construction materials such as toilets, sinks, vanities, windows, drywall, lumber, ceramic tile, broken concrete, asphalt, doors, etc., are not collected.



WHERE'S THE REST OF 2023?

The Province of Ontario is transitioning recycle collection away from municipalities like the City of

Sarnia and placing responsiblity in the hands of those who produce recyclable materials. Starting on July 1, 2023, these producers will take on the collection of recycling in Sarnia.

What will this look like? Producers are still finalizing the details. It may be that recycling collection schedules stay exactly the same, but until we know we're holding off on a full-year waste calendar.

A second calendar for July to December will be sent to all our residents before July 1 with a final collection schedule.
