



Option 1: Environment First

Environment

- Environmental focus for all actions
- Enhance natural areas: woodland, meadows, dune, wetland
- Create positive drainage
- Enhance Lake Chipican and its connection to Lake Huron
- Improve wildlife habitat

Access

- Reconsider location of roads and parking
- Context sensitive trail design in naturalized areas
- Close access to areas where habitat needs to be restored

Activity/Events

- Locate facilities only in locations that do not interrupt the natural heritage/drainage system
- Size and type of event only in locations where there's no impact on natural heritage; many of events are relocated to downtown locations

Option 2: Re-Establish a Tourist Node



Environment

- Enhance natural areas: woodland, meadows, dune, wetland
- Enhance Lake Chipican and its connection to Lake Huron
- Improve wildlife habitat

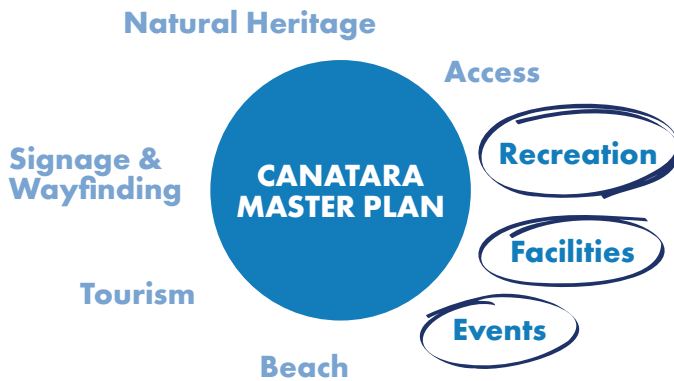
Access

- Maintain roads generally where they are located
- Re-organize parking
- Establish trail/cycling loops
- Re-introduce public transit to the park

Activity/Events

- Node to re-establish a small area for tourist accommodation, year round restaurant, centre for events
- Maybe yurts or camping in Tarzanland
- Year round events

Option 3: Recreation Focused



Environment

Access

- Maintain roads generally where they are located
- Re-organize parking
- Establish trail/cycling loops
- Re-introduce public transit to the park

Activity/Events

- Broad spectrum of recreation activities: pickle ball, basketball, beach volleyball, beach rentals, canoe/kayak launch, exercise stations, adventure based playground
- Year round events
- Food trucks, seasonal food
