REGULATIONS FOR A PRIVATE FIREWORKS DISPLAY

Obligation of Persons using Fireworks.

Any persons using fireworks shall adhere to **By-Law Number 68 of 2022 of the City of Sarnia**, also known as the "**Fireworks By-Law**". This includes, but is not limited to, the following:

No person under the age of eighteen (18) years may purchase or detonate fireworks.

No person shall discharge any prohibited fireworks.

No person shall discharge any fireworks on days other than Permitted Use Days (the day fixed for observance of Victoria Day, the first day of July, and one day prior and one day following each of the foregoing days) unless permitted by the Chief Fire Official

The Private Fireworks Display shall be held on private property, at a safe distance from all streets, highways, buildings and other structures.

Any person who holds a Private Fireworks Display assumes all responsibility for any personal injury, property damage, claims, causes of action or damages or any nature or kind, whatsoever.

Only "Recreational Fireworks" as defined in said By-law are permitted to be used for a Private Fireworks Display.

No person shall detonate any Recreational Fireworks on public property.

Any person holding a Private Fireworks Display shall take every reasonable precaution for the safety of others.

Any or all infractions may be subject to fines.
